Q5 What policies would you propose to promote continued job growth for private employers, including both nonprofit and for-profit business employers? (Limit: 250 words)

From a state level perspective I advocate for strategies can grow the economic pie. These could consist of fiscal and investment policies to stimulate job creation and economic growth.
